Abstract Guidelines

The deadline for submission of abstracts is: February 28, 2010.

To ensure the initial acceptance of your abstract, please adhere to the following formatting guidelines:

1. Abstracts must be single paged.
2. Font: Times New Roman, size 12.
3. Margins: Left = 1.5 inches, all others = 1 inch.
4. Include complete title in bold.
5. Limit the use of special font effects to "bold," "underline" and "italics.
6. You may provide 2-3 references as part of the abstract
7. Contact information (e-mail, phone and fax) for the presenting author must be displayed immediately below the title of the abstract.
8. Please provide two copies of the abstract; one with author information as above and the other with only the title followed by the body of the abstract without author information.

Abstracts are to be submitted only in MS Word. Documents created in MS Word versions "97" through "2007" will be accepted by e-mail, only to tfuhrman@med.miami.edu.
