**MEMBER HIGHLIGHT** Dr. Rosemarie Garcia Getting

Dr. Rosemarie Garcia Getting has been a valued member of the FSA since 2006, when she joined as a medical student. Over the years, she has served the FSA in many capacities, including as 3 West District Director, as Chair of the FSA Committee on Professional Diversity and most recently as a Delegate to the ASA House of Delegates. She founded the FSA Ambassador Program, which offers mentorship to new members and aims to promote diversity within FSA leadership. Dr. Garcia Getting's passion for diversity stems from her own experience overcoming the unique challenges faced by women physician leaders. She is inspired by her parents, who immigrated to the U.S. from Cuba and successfully pursued professional careers.

Dr. Garcia Getting, MD FASA earned her medical degree at Florida State University College of Medicine and completed her anesthesiology residency at the University of Flor-

ida in 2011. For over 10 years, she has served on the faculty at Moffitt Cancer Center in Tampa, where she specializes in onco-anesthesiology, the perioperative care of patients with cancer. Dr. Garcia Getting is the Associate Program Director for Moffitt's Onco-Anesthesiology Fellowship Program, one of only 3 programs of its kind in the country. She is an Associate Professor at the University of South Florida Morsani College of Medicine, where she is actively involved in teaching medical students and serves as Faculty Advisor for the Anesthesiology Interest Group. Prior to taking on the role of Associate Program Director, Dr. Garcia Getting served as Medical Director of Moffitt's ambulatory surgical center for 5 years.

Outside of her work, Dr. Garcia Getting enjoys the company of her husband and their 3 children. As Florida natives, they love the beach and sunshine.
